


Time Keeping & Getting Paid



As of now, you should be able to download the Paylocity App and log in. Our primary goal for your first week is to make sure you track your time worked accurately. Please read the attached essential guide, which contains all the details and answers to your questions.

Options for clocking in:

- Use the app and clock in on your home screen
- Use a chrome-book and log into Paylocity to clock in
- Or call dispatch and they will document your time for you
