If your travel plans include stops within the Town of Gypsum, here's what you need to know:

*Paying a fare is required for all trips involving stops within the Town of Gypsum, whether you are boarding or exiting the bus.

Boarding in Dotsero and Traveling Eastbound to Gypsum on the Valley East Route:

- You may board the bus using either the front or back doors while in Dotsero.
- You have the option to pay your fare upon boarding or when exiting the bus in Gypsum.
- When you pay your fare upon boarding, the driver will give you a token as proof of payment. Please keep this token and return it to the driver when you exit the bus as verification of payment.

Boarding in Gypsum and traveling Eastbound to Eagle, Edwards, Avon, Beaver Creek, or Vail on the Valley East Route:

- In Gypsum, which is designated as a "Fare Zone," all passengers must use the front door only to board and exit the bus.
- You must pay your fare upon boarding.

Fare Information for Town of Gypsum Stops:

- The standard fare is \$3 per ride.
- Discounted rates are available for Youth, Seniors, and Military Personnel: \$2 per ride if paying in cash or \$1 per ride if using the "ECO Tickets" mobile app.

Boarding in Vail, Avon, Beaver Creek, Edwards, or Eagle and traveling to Gypsum on the Valley West Route:

- You may board the bus using either the front or back doors while in fare-free zones.
- If exiting in Gypsum, you can choose to pay your fare upon boarding or when exiting.
- When you pay your fare upon boarding, the driver will give you a token as proof of payment. Please keep this token and return it to the driver when you exit the bus as verification of payment.
- In Gypsum, which is designated as a "Fare Zone," all passengers must use the front door only to board and exit the bus.

Please Note: Drivers do not carry cash. If you do not have the exact fare, the fare box will issue a change card for the difference. This change card can be used for future rides and is valid for one year. It can also be used by other passengers. Please remember change cards cannot be exchanged for cash. For example, if you pay with a \$5 bill for a \$3 fare, you will receive a change card valued at \$2. When you pay with cash and receive a change card this is not to be used as proof of purchase of the ride. Only a token can be returned for proof of paid fare that is received at the time you board with payment and then returned to the driver on your departure.
